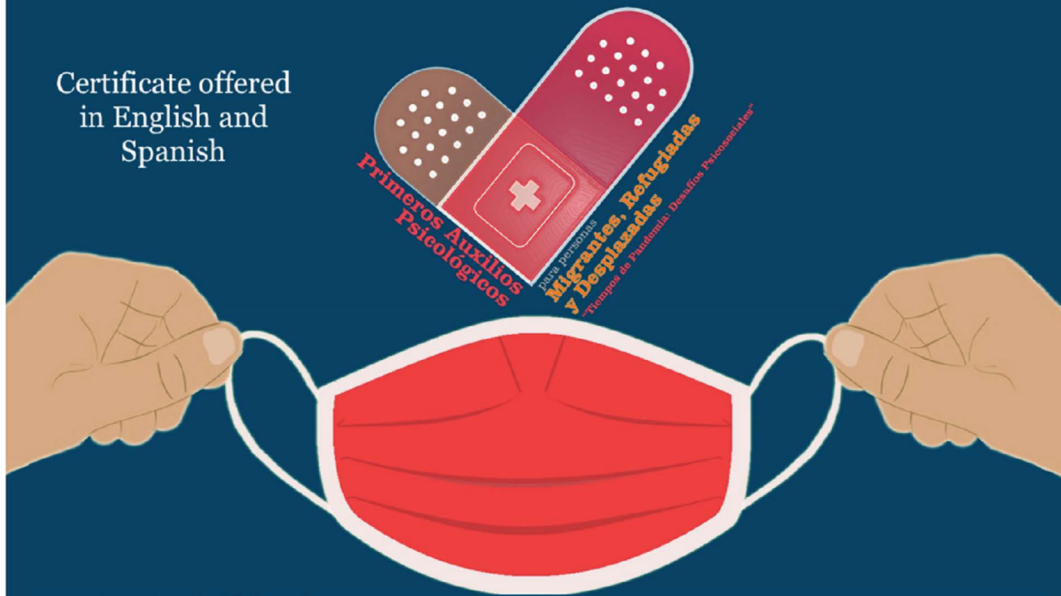


# 6<sup>th</sup> Edition of the Psychological First Aid for Migrants, Refugees and Displaced Persons
