



Recovery Action Fund for Tomorrow (RAFT)

JEWISH FAMILY SERVICE OF SAN DIEGO

RAFT will provide one-time cash distributions to families and seniors in the amount of \$4,000 to address the growing need for flexible funds, connect participants to resources that help maximize the receipt of these funds, and support them in planning for their future. Families and seniors who are at-risk of experiencing homelessness will be prioritized. The program will serve the San Diego County 39 Health Equity Zip Codes, and support residents earning 200% or less of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL).

Participant Eligibility Criteria

- Families with children under 18 years of age
- Seniors (aged 55 and over)
- Families caring for dependent or disabled adults may also apply
- Recipient must be at least 18 years of age
- Household income at or below 200% Federal Poverty Level (\$60,000 per year for a family of 4)
- San Diego County resident of 39 Health Equity ZIP codes disproportionately impacted by COVID-19
